The University of Vienna is the commissioner, i.e. responsible for the data processing in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Keeping in line with the duty of the person responsible to make this information clear and available, we ask you to take note of the following:

The University of Vienna processes the following categories of personal data as part of the data processing in question (please select):

Furthermore, you also have the option of revoking your consent to data processing at any time without giving reasons. Ultimately, you have the option of complaining to the Austrian data protection authority (www.dsb.gv.at) about what you consider to be inadmissible data processing.
